We have a general internal medicine department to treat routine acute illnesses such as colds, stomachaches, and diarrhea, as well as lifestyle-related diseases, and a psychiatry department to treat mental and physical disorders caused by stress and other factors.



- cold, stomachache, vomit, diarrhea, rash, etc
- Chronic diseases such as high blood pressure, diabetes, hyperlipemia and hyperuricemia
- Medication for allergic rhinitis, asthma, constipation, etc
- Vaccination (influenza, meningococcus, etc)

## • Headache, malaise, loss of appetite, etc due to stress and sleep

 Common mental diseases such as adjustment disorder, depression, anxiety disorder
